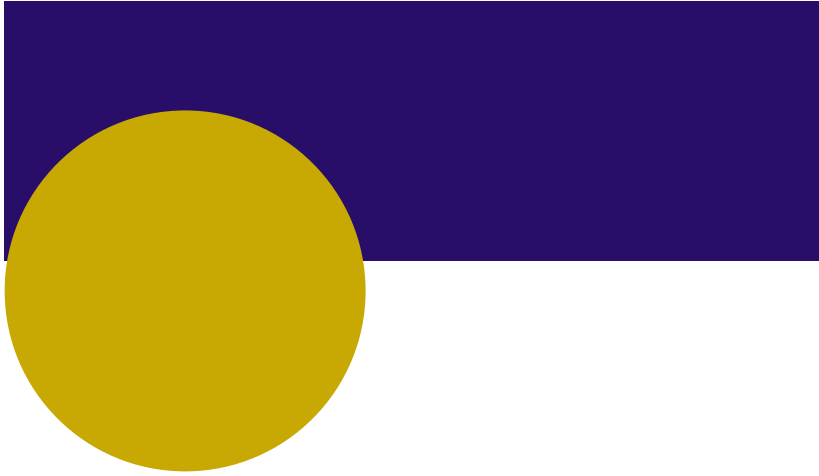
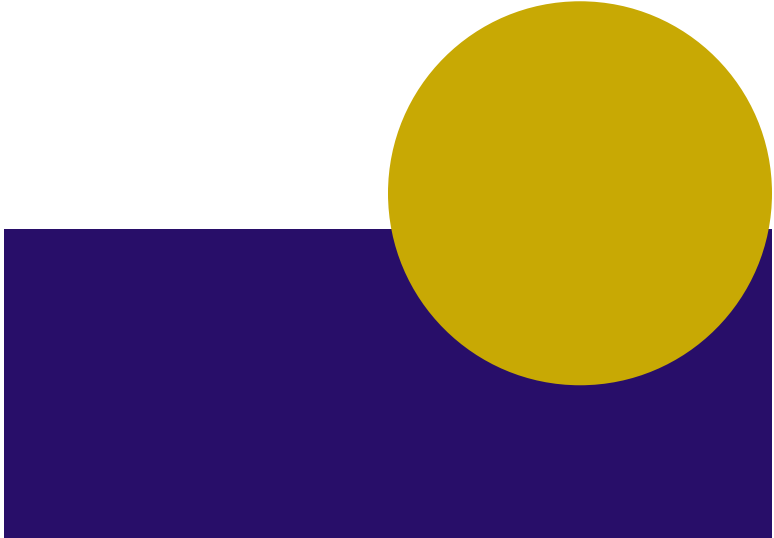

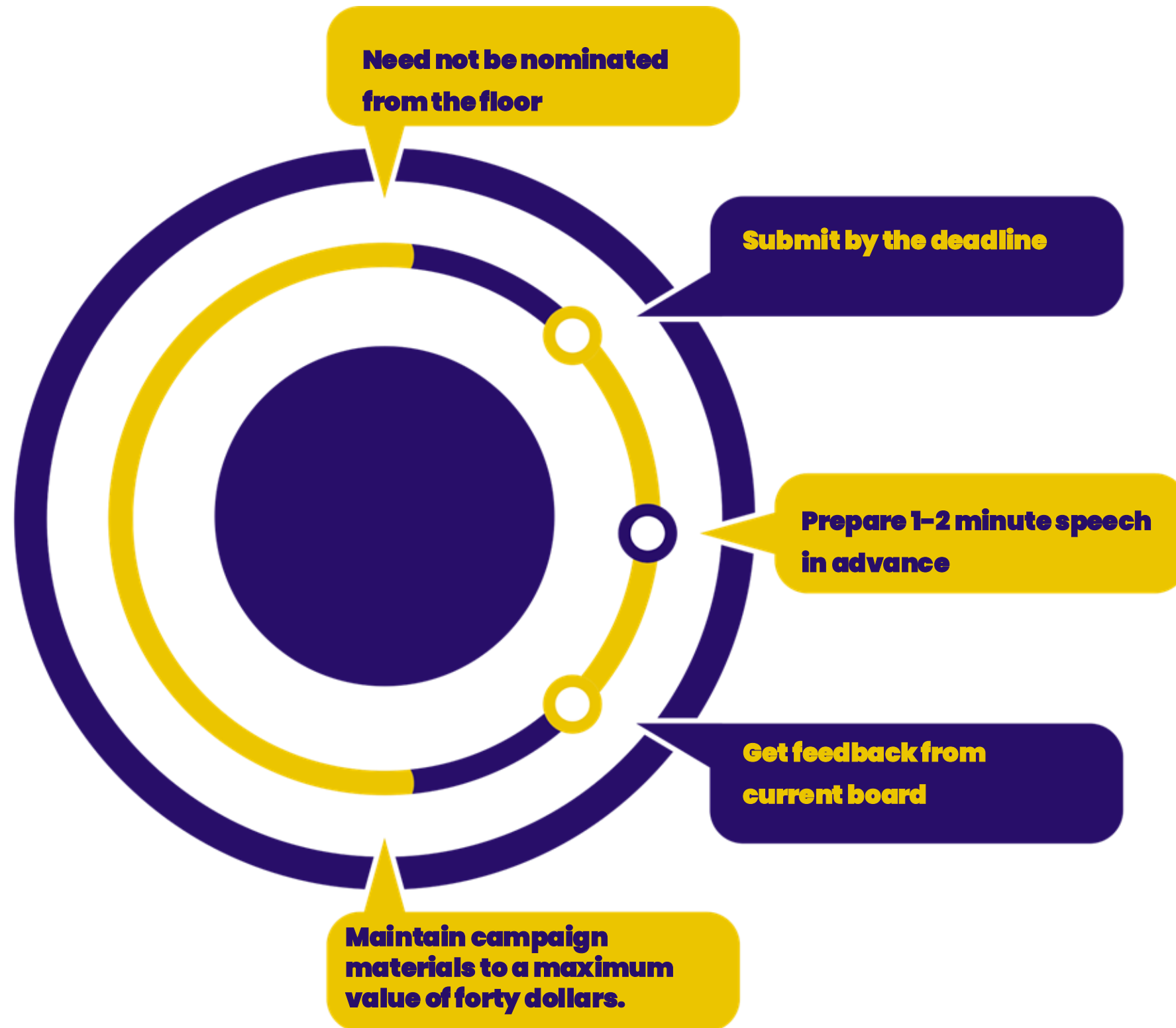

SUBMIT APPLICATION ONLINE

Deadline: Friday, Nov 6th @ 4pm

Nominations from the floor will be requested during the House of Delegates meeting.

Campaigning may begin after candidate has been notified by a member of the Nominations and Elections Committee that all papers are in order and the candidate's name has been added to the slate board posted at convention.

To place a name in nomination, a member should approach the microphone and, after being recognized, should say: "Madame President, I nominate _____ from _____ for the office of _____. She/he has consented to serve."
Nominations do not require a second.



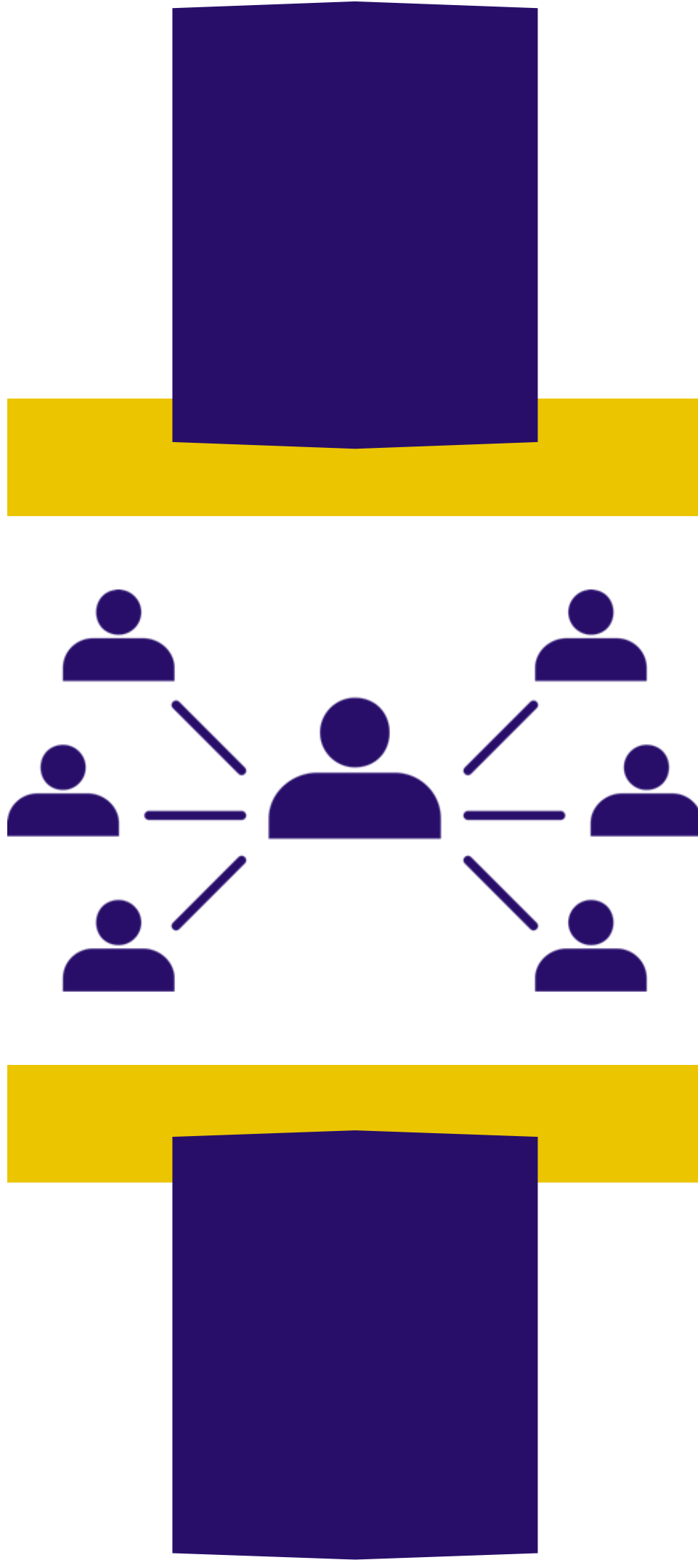
SPEECHES
